Eric N. Olson Mentorship Award (ENOMA) Nomination Guidelines

The Eric N. Olson Mentorship Award (ENOMA) at ISHR NAS has been established to recognize a faculty member with a clear dedication to mentorship and support of trainees and young scientists (see Dr. Olson's bio <u>Eric Olson Bio</u>). The basis for consideration for the ENOMA is the quality of mentorship provided, and not simply the number of mentees. Nominees must be current members of ISHR NAS. The deadline for submitting a nomination package is **April 1, 2024**.

1. NOMINATION:

- Nomination packages should include:
 - ✓ A nomination letter, not exceeding two pages, clearly describing how the nominee exemplifies excellence in mentorship. The letter should be written by two or more of the nominee's past and/or current trainees.
 - \checkmark A copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae.
 - \checkmark NIH biosketches of the trainees who are making the nomination.
 - ✓ Additional letters of support may be appended, but the total number of letters should not exceed five, inclusive of the nomination letter.
- Please send the nomination package as a single, compiled PDF file (< 20MB) to <u>kelleybrodsky.ishrnas@gmail.com</u> by **April 1, 2024**
- 2. AWARD:
 - a. The ENOMA committee will evaluate all nominations, and will select a winner to be recognized at NAS2023 Madison conference. This award consists of a recognition plaque and a \$3,000 check.
 - b. The winner will be required to present the NAS ENOMA Lecture at the NAS2024 Long Beach, CA meeting **August 19-23, 2024**
 - c. The winner will be announced by May 1, 2024
