The Jeff Robbins Collaborative Science Award

International Society for Heart Research – North American Section (ISHR-NAS)

Purpose

The *Jeff Robbins Collaborative Science Award* recognizes individuals who exemplify the spirit of scientific collaboration, mentorship, and innovation embodied by the late Professor Jeff Robbins. This award honors senior investigators who have made significant contributions to cardiovascular research through collaborative leadership, sustained mentorship, and dedication to advancing the next generation of scientists.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be **established investigators** (Professor level or equivalent) with a **documented record of impactful collaborative research** and a strong mentoring record in cardiovascular science.
- Applicants must be **current members of the ISHR-North American Section (ISHR-NAS)**.
- Previous recipients of the award are **not eligible**.
- The awardee must **register, attend, and be present** at the ISHR-NAS Annual Meeting to receive the award.

Application Requirements

- A complete application package must include the following materials, compiled as a **single PDF file (<20 MB)**:
- **Cover Letter and Summary Statement (1 page maximum)**
 - Self-nomination or nomination by others is acceptable
 - Provide a concise narrative describing your collaborative research efforts, mentoring philosophy, and contributions to advancing team-based cardiovascular science.
 - The statement should highlight specific collaborative initiatives, training activities, and leadership roles that have strengthened research networks and mentorship culture.
 - Use **Arial 11-point font, single spacing (≤55 lines)**.
- **Curriculum Vitae (Full CV)**
 - Include key publications, funded research, leadership positions, and evidence of mentorship or collaborative impact.
- **Two Letters of Support (1 page each)**
 - Letters may come from a **former trainee**, a **key collaborator**, or a **department chair** who can attest to the applicant's leadership, mentorship, and collaborative contributions.
